Birding and wildlife tour

Jan 09 – Jan 23, 2018

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Introduction

This report contains short notes on our 15 days trip to Uganda with a list of the species of birds and mammals we saw.

We chose Uganda because of the rich wildlife and birdlife of East Africa. Two years earlier we went on a classic safari in Kenya's highland with focus on the big mammals of Masai Mara and the birds at the big lakes. This time we wanted to enjoy the very rich birdlife of neighboring Uganda's forests and lakes. The wish list included Shoebill, Skimmer, Chimpanzee and the endemic bird species of the Albertine Rift.

The safari program was arranged for us by Avian Safaris (Crammy Wanyama) (<http://www.aviansafaris.com/>) . For the first 12 days, we were accompanied by Veronicah (guide) and Ibrahim (driver). Both of them were very competent to find and identify the many bird species, to help us with practical matters and to get us safe around in Uganda, thanks for that.

Itinerary

Tuesday Jan 9. We arrived late evening in Entebbe and were met by Vero and Ibrahim in the airport. We drove to 2 Friends Beach Hotel on the shore of Lake Victoria to stay the next two nights.

Wednesday Jan 10. We started off at 7 am for Mabamba Swamps 1½ hour drive from Entebbe with several short stops when new bird species showed up. (This was more or less the daily routine of the tour). In the big papyrus swamp we went by a small boat (canoe) through channels to the home of the Shoebill. This incredible – nearly prehistoric – species was maybe the most wanted species for us, and we met two in this swamp. And we had good views and plenty of time to watch and get the right camera shots. One of them caught a big (lung)fish. Of course, we also saw many other wetland birds like Pied and Malachite Kingfishers, Long-toed Lapwing, Purple and Black Heron, Blue-breasted Bee-eater, African Marsh-Harrier and Lesser and African Jacana.

In the afternoon we visited Entebbe Botanical Garden. Although this is a city park, there is a very rich birdlife, and it presents a good introduction to Uganda's nature. In the big old trees, we saw Great Blue Turaco, Eastern Plantain-eater, Crowned Hornbill and Black-and-white-casqued Hornbill. At the shore of Lake Victoria, there was a good representation of wetland-birds like African Openbill, Marabou Stork, Long-tailed Cormorant, Hamerkop, Black-headed Heron, Great Egret, Little Egret, Cattle Egret, Squacco Heron, Hadada Ibis, Black-winged Stilt, Spur-winged Lapwing, Malachite and Pied Kingfisher. Black Kites were in the air all the time.



Thursday Jan 11. We headed for Lake Mburo National Park, but before noon, we made a stop to visit Mpanga Forest. It is an old protected forest, where we saw Double-toothed Barbet, White-throated Bee-eater, Black-and-white-casqued Hornbill and Narina Tropicbird among others.

Along the road to Mburo, we saw many different species, especially when we came closer to Mburo. Lizard Buzzard, Long-crested Eagle, Bare-faced Go-away-bird, Speckled Pigeon, Green-spotted Wood-dove and several species of sunbirds. We stayed at Rwakobo Lodge on the top of a big rock with beautiful view over the savanna landscape.

Friday Jan 12. In the morning, we drove through the national park to Lake Mburo. In the savanna with scattered Acacia trees, we saw several small flocks of Impala and a few Zebras, Topi, Waterbuck, Bushbuck and Buffalo. Inside the park, there are tall grass and many bushes and trees, outside the park the savanna is heavily grazed by longhorn cattle. We then had a boat ride on the lake with many Hippos and African Fish Eagle everywhere. We saw Little Bittern, Striated Heron and Shining Blue Kingfisher hiding in the papyrus swamps along parts of the lakeshore. At the more open shore, there was Water Thick-knee and Black Crake. Then suddenly, the highlight of the day: African Finfoot. First a male that caught a frog, then later on a female. Very fine birds.

After lunch at the lodge, we did a game drive through the park. We had Lapped-faced and White-backed Vulture, Palm-nut Vulture, Bateleur, Brown and Banded Snake-Eagle, Wahlberg's and Tawny Eagle, Red-necked and Crested Francolin, Wattled Lapwing, Common Scimitarbill, and Pygmy, Woodland and Striped Kingfisher, Red-headed Lovebird, Yellow-throated Longclaw and more. Today it rained shortly.

Saturday Jan 13. Before dawn, we looked for nocturnal species around the lodge, and we were lucky to see a Freckled Nightjar on the surface of the rock. After some more birding around the rock, we continued towards Ruhija of Bwindi Impenetrable National Park. From the road, we saw more new species like White-backed Duck, Spur-winged Goose, Little Grebe, Augur Buzzard, Blue-naped Mousebird, Cinnamon-chested Bee-eater, Common Fiscal, White-naped Raven, Flappet Lark and Grosbeak Weaver.

In Ruhija, we stayed at Gorilla Mist Camp, a fine small lodge with view to the forested mountain slopes.

Sunday Jan 14. Today, we hiked through Bwindi Forest to Mubwindi Swamp. It is potentially possible to see 23 Albertine Rift endemic species in this area. All in all, we saw 14 of these: African Green Broadbill, Dusky Crimsonwing, Regal Sunbird, Blue-headed Sunbird, Rwenzori Batis, Yellow-eyed Black Flycatcher, Grauer's Warbler, Grauer's Rush Warbler, Mountain Masked Apalis, Archer's Robin-Chat, Handsome Francolin, Red-faced Woodland Warbler, Strange Weaver and Stripe-breasted Tit. Above the treetops, White-headed and Black Sawwing flew.

Beside the many birds, we could see that this part of the forest is home to both Gorilla and Elephant. There were many fresh footprints and droppings along the path. The forest is quite open with a dense lower vegetation, probably influenced by the “grazing” of the elephants. We also saw the little forest antelope Blue Duiker.

Monday Jan 15. After a morning tour around Ruhija, we drove through the “Neck” – a narrow connection between the protected forests of Bwindi – to Buhoma. Today, we saw African Black Duck, Yellowbill, Dusky Long-tailed Cuckoo, African Black Swift, Shining-blue Kingfisher, Black Bee-eater, Speckled Tinkerbird, Willcock’s Honeyguide, Northern Puffback, Mountain Sooty Boubou, Petit’s Cuckoo-shrike, African Paradise-Flycatcher, Stripe-breasted Tit, Red-faced Woodland-Warbler, Black-collared and Chestnut-throated Apalis, Stuhlmann’s Starling, Little Green Sunbird, Regal and Variable Sunbird, Golden-breasted Bunting, Black-billed Weaver, and more. On the road, a boy showed us a beautiful Rwenzori Three-horned Chameleon.



In Buhoma, we stayed at Bwindi View, a rather basic lodge, but with good service and many sunbirds around.

Tuesday Jan 16. We went up the Buhoma-Bwindi Main Trail. Here, we met Red-tailed Monkey, L’Hoest’s Monkey, Blue Monkey, and heard Chimpanzee. Also, Black-fronted Duiker was seen. New bird species were Ayres’s Hawk-Eagle, Bronze-naped Pigeon, Bar-tailed Trogon, Blue-throated Roller, African Broadbill, Chestnut Wattle-eye, Pink-footed Puffback, Grey-green (Bocage’s) Bush-Shrike, Many-coloured Bush-Shrike, Dusky Tit, Honeyguide Greenbul, Green Crombec, Grey Apalis, Olive-green Camaroptera, Sooty and Dusky-blue Flycatcher, Equatorial Akalat, Narrow-tailed Starling, Green-throated Sunbird, Thick-billed Seedeater, Red-headed Malimbe and Black-necked Weaver.

Wednesday Jan 17. Today, we drove to Queen Elizabeth National Park. The southern part is large savanna landscape. Here, we looked in vain for the tree-climbing lions; instead, we had flocks of Kob, a few Elephant, Topi, Buffalo, Waterbuck and far away on the road, a Leopard. A long, black (probable) Jackson’s Tree Snake crossed the road. There were many birds of prey like Black-shouldered Kite, Palm-nut Vulture, White-backed Vulture, Bateleur, Banded Snake-Eagle, Long-crested Eagle, Lizard and Augur Buzzard. Even our familiar Common Buzzard was here.

Further north, we came to the big Lake Edward and Kazinga Channel, where we stayed at Bush Lodge. This is a fine lodge overlooking the broad Channel, and we tried a safari tent as well as a cottage – both of them were good to stay in. At night, the Hippos came up from the lake to feed from the land-vegetation close to the lodge. We saw Baboons, Warthogs, Giant Forest Hog and Bushbuck, and heard Hyenas here.



Thursday Jan 18. In the morning, we had a game drive around the park. In the savanna, we saw many raptors like African Harrier-Hawk, Palm-nut Vulture, Lapped-faced and White-backed Vulture, Bateleur, Black-breasted and Brown Snake-Eagle, Martial and Long-crested Eagle and Eurasian Marsh-Harrier. New species were Black-bellied Bustard, Mourning Collared-Dove, White-tailed Lark, Red-capped Lark, Croaking and Zitting Cisticola, Northern Wheatear and Yellow-fronted Canary. The savanna was very dry, and we did not see any Elephants and only few Kob and Waterbuck.

In the afternoon, we drove to Mweya from where we sailed in a big boat with other tourists. On the shore of Kazinga Channel, the Elephants came down by the water to eat fresh vegetation, and we had good views of several family groups. Big flocks of Hippopotamus and Buffalos also gather here. Very interesting for us was a part of the shore with many northern migrants familiar to us: Great Cormorant, Common Ringed Plover, Black-tailed Godwit, Ruddy Turnstone, Ruff, Curlew Sandpiper, Sanderling, Little Stint, Common Sandpiper, Common Greenshank, Wood Sandpiper, Caspian/Herring Gull, Lesser Black-backed Gull and Gull-billed Tern. One of the Lesser Black-backed Gulls was ringed, and we later found out that this bird was ringed as young 18½ years ago in Finland, more than 6700 km to the north (!). Even better though was a big roosting flock of Skimmers, a species we very much wished to see. Other new species were Yellow-billed Stork, African Spoonbill, Kittlitz's Plover, Three-banded Plover, Slender-billed and Grey-hooded Gull and Red-throated Bee-eater.

Friday Jan 19. Before heading north towards Kibale Forest, we made a few stops in Queen Elizabeth Nat. Park. Along the road, we saw Pallid Harrier, Diederick Cuckoo and Papyrus Gonolek, and we caught sight of a single Lion far away in the savanna.

Arriving at Kibale Forest, we had lunch at Chimpanzee Forest Guesthouse where we stayed the next two nights. This is a very fine lodge with well-spaced cottages overlooking the hilly landscape with tea fields.


In the afternoon, we visited Bigodi Wetland just outside the national park. This marsh with tree-cover has a path around it, and we saw monkeys and Grey Parrot among others. At the lodge, we saw Magpie Mannikin, Red-billed Firefinch and Violet-backed Starling.

Saturday Jan 20. One hour before dawn, we went out in the forest to search for the rare and secretive Green-breasted Pitta. But despite a very long search, we did not see or hear any. Around dawn, we saw Bushbabies – Demidoff's Galago in the treetops, also Red-tailed Monkey and Mantled Guereza were seen. We heard Afep Pigeon, Red-chested Oulet, Narina Trogon and Blue-breasted Kingfisher, and we saw Tambourine Dove, Great Blue Turaco, Yellowbill, Crowned and Black-and-white-casqued Hornbill and Grey-throated Flycatcher. Accidentally, we met one Chimpanzee sitting on the ground.

In the afternoon, we had better luck with the Chimpanzee tracking. After some search and call from another guide, we met first three Chimpanzees and then six more. They were sitting restful in the forest-floor trying to ignore the group of tourists watching and taking hundreds of pictures. After one hour in company with the chimpanzees, they went away and disappeared in the forest. This was a great experience.

Sunday Jan 21. This day was spent on the road back to Entebbe. We made stops whenever something interesting showed up. A Black Kite heavily chased a Wahlberg's Eagle; back home, a photo showed that the eagle probably stole a young from the kite's nest. Red-faced Cisticola, Northern Brown-throated Weaver, Rufous Flycatcher-Thrush and others were seen.

We returned to 2 Friends Beach Hotel for the next two nights and could thank Vero and Ibrahim for very good company during the tour.

Monday-Tuesday Jan 22-23. We spent the last two days relaxing, walking in the Botanical Garden and doing a little shopping. The Botanical Garden was very rewarding with even new birds and other animals. Swimming in the lake was a Nile Monitor and a group of 5-6 Speckle-throated Otter. New bird species were African Swallow-tailed Kite (one overflying), Rüppel's Griffon Vulture (one flying bird with mottled belly and light bill), Shikra, Whiskered Tern, Ross's Turaco, African Golden Oriole, Brown Babbler, Spectacled Weaver, Orange Weaver and Black-and-white Mannikin.

The return flight was late in the evening, so we booked the hotel room for an extra day. The trip back to Denmark went well.

Practical Information

- The travel route from Denmark was Billund-Amsterdam-Entebbe by KLM. The flight to Entebbe has a stop in Kigali (Rwanda), so the flight out is two hours longer than the flight back.
- We visited Uganda in one of the dry months, and we had only something like two rain showers. There were several cloudy days. Some nights were cool in the mountain area. There were not mosquitos of any significance.
- The handbooks we used were: Stevenson & Fanshawe: Birds of East Africa, Kingdon: The Kingdon Pocket Guide to African Mammals, Withers & Hosking: Wildlife of East Africa. We also used the map from International Travel Maps: Uganda scale 1:600,000.
- For photos we used Nikon D750 with 200-400 mm/f4 + 1,4 converter and Nikon D610 with 24-120 mm/f4. Tripod was not used.




